

502. - The person who redeems the property recovers it free from any rights created by the original buyer or his heirs or transferees before redemption.

If a hire of property held subject to a right of redemption is registered by the proper competent official it shall be valid for not more than one year of its remaining duration, provided that ~~the hire~~ it is not made for the purpose of injuring the seller.

507. - If the property is to be examined by the buyer before delivery and the buyer does not examine and accept it within the time fixed by the contract, usage or ~~by a~~ notification from the seller, the ~~contract is extinguished~~ latter is no longer bound.

508. - When the property has been delivered to the buyer in order that he may examine it, the sale is complete in the following cases :

(1) if the buyer does not notify his refusal within the time fixed by the contract, usage or ~~by the~~ notification, or

(2) if the buyer does not return the property within that time, or

(3) if the buyer pays the price or part of it, or

(4) if the buyer disposes of the property or does any other act from which acceptance may be implied.
