

CHAPTER III.
DUTIES OF THE BUYER.

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427. — The price of the property sold may be either fixed by the contract or inferred from the clauses of the contract or from the circumstances of the case.

428. — Tender of security is not equivalent to payment of price.

CHAPTER IV.
OF SOME PARTICULAR KINDS OF SALES.

[Part] 1. — SALE WITH RIGHT OF REDEMPTION.

429. — Sale with right of redemption is a contract of sale whereby the ownership of the property sold passes to the buyer subject to a special agreement that the seller can redeem that property.

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
